A BILL

To amend the Indian Employment, Training and Related Services Demonstration Act of 1992 to modify a provision relating to integration of services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INTEGRATION OF SERVICES.**

4 Section 4 of the Indian Employment, Training and
5 Related Services Demonstration Act of 1992 (25 U.S.C.
6 3403) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “The Secretary” and inserting
8 the following:

9 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary”; and

10 (2) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(b) FUNDING REQUIREMENTS.—Notwithstanding
2 the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance
3 Act (25 U.S.C. 450 et seq.) or any other provision of law,
4 or any auditing or reporting circular of the Office of Man-
5 agement and Budget or related compliance memoranda,
6 effective beginning on the date of enactment of this sub-
7 section—

8 “(1) any funds supplied by a Federal depart-
9 ment or agency to carry out a plan under this sec-
10 tion shall be consolidated and made available to the
11 applicable Indian tribe or tribal organization pursu-
12 ant to an existing contract, compact, or funding
13 agreement under title I or IV of the Indian Self-De-
14 termination and Education Assistance Act (25
15 U.S.C. 450 et seq.), to the maximum extent prac-
16 ticable; and

17 “(2) no Indian tribe or tribal organization car-
18 rying out a plan under this section shall be required
19 to separately account for the expenditure of the
20 funds of each Federal department or agency after
21 the date on which the funds are consolidated and
22 paid to the Indian tribe or tribal organization under
23 paragraph (1).”.
