Subject: H.J. Res. 100 - Continuing Resolution

I just wanted to let you know that the President signed the above referenced Continuing Resolution on Friday, November 17, 2006. The Public Law number is 109-369 and the enrolled bill language is attached for your information and use. It covers the period through December 8, 2006.

Congress is in recess until December 4, 2006. I have been informed that it is likely that the 109th Congress will adjourn without completing all appropriations bills. Currently, the Departments of Defense and Homeland Security Appropriations for 2007 are completed. It is unclear what time period the next Continuing Resolution is likely to cover.

Joint Resolution

Making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2007, and for other purposes.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2007 (Public Law 109-289, division B) is amended by striking the date specified in section 106(3) and inserting "December 8, 2006".
