The Department of Justice and the Department of the Interior released the Tribal Law and Order Act (TLOA) congressionally-mandated Long Term Plan to Build and Enhance Tribal Justice Systems (Tribal Justice Plan), which responds to TLOA sections 211, 241, and 244. The Tribal Justice Plan addresses incarceration in Indian Country, alternatives to incarceration, and offender reentry.
