We recently learned that the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the Department of the Treasury were able to develop guidelines that will allow American Indians and Alaska Natives eligible for service through the Indian Health Service (IHS) to obtain a hardship exemption from the shared responsibility payment through the tax filing process.

We were elated to hear that the Administration worked collaboratively to find a solution that will help maximize the number of American Indians and Alaska Natives who will be able to benefit from this exemption.
