**Course Description:** Required training for Law Enforcement Officers to be eligible to receive a Special Law Enforcement Commission (SLEC) from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Office of Justice Services. All SLEC applicants must pass this course examination with a score of 70% or higher to meet SLEC eligibility requirements.

**Who Should Attend:** Law Enforcement Officers whose department has a current SLEC agreement in place with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

**Application Deadline:** January 20, 2017

**Instructors:** The course is presented by the United States Attorney's Office, District of New Mexico.
