



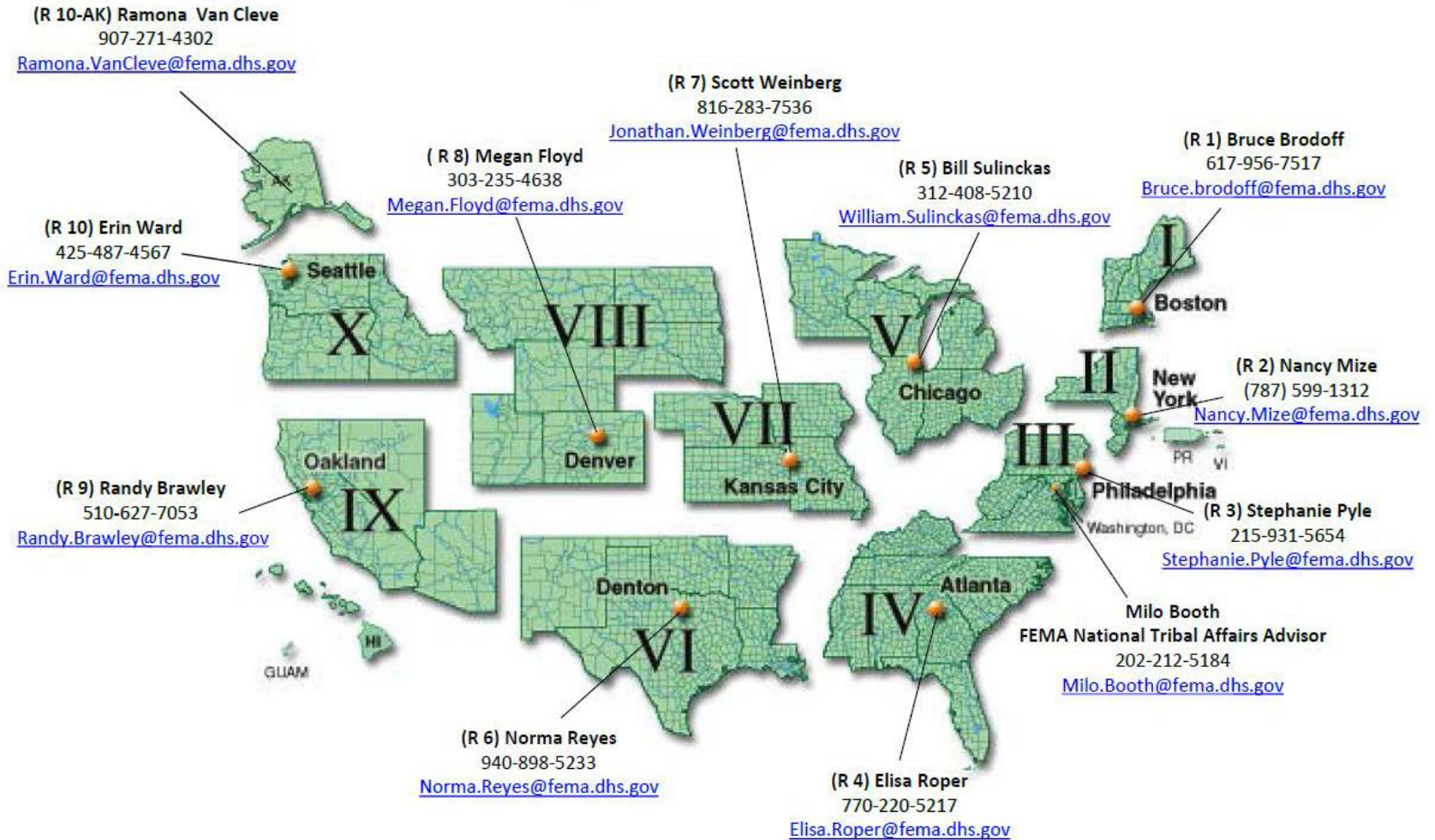

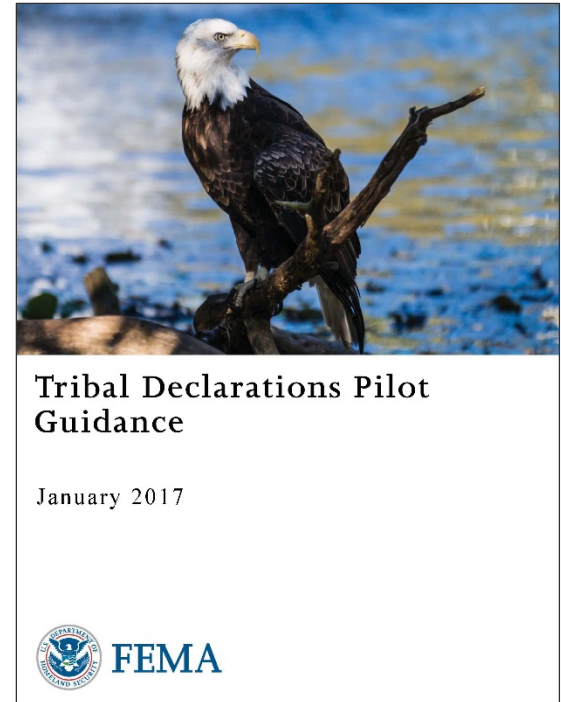

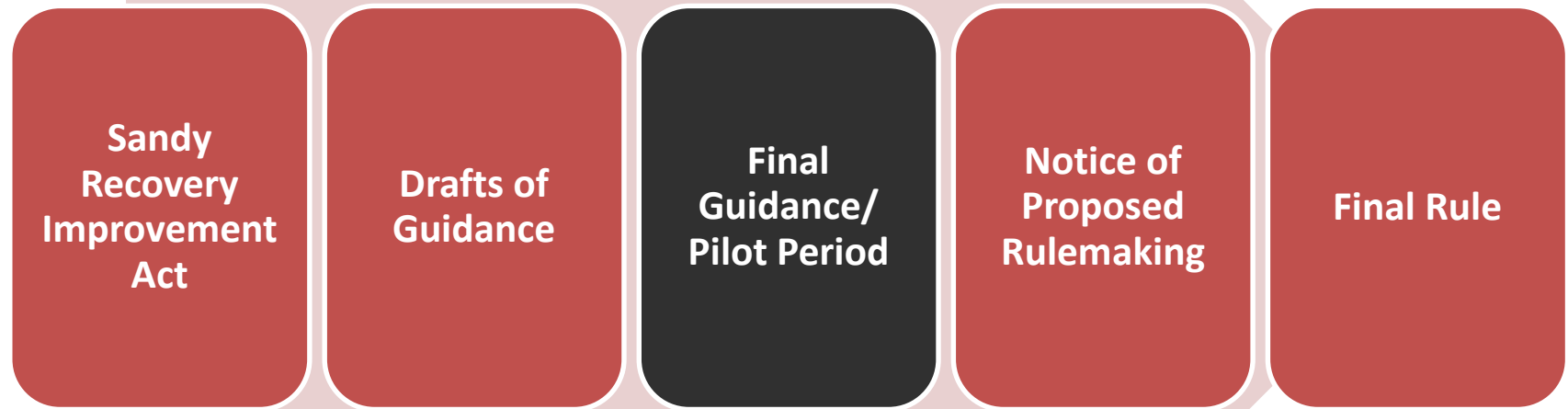
Tribal Pilot Declarations Guide

- Posted to the Federal Register 1/10/17
- Over 500 tribal officials representing 178 federally-recognized tribal governments participated in 54 listening sessions.
- FEMA received 800 comments

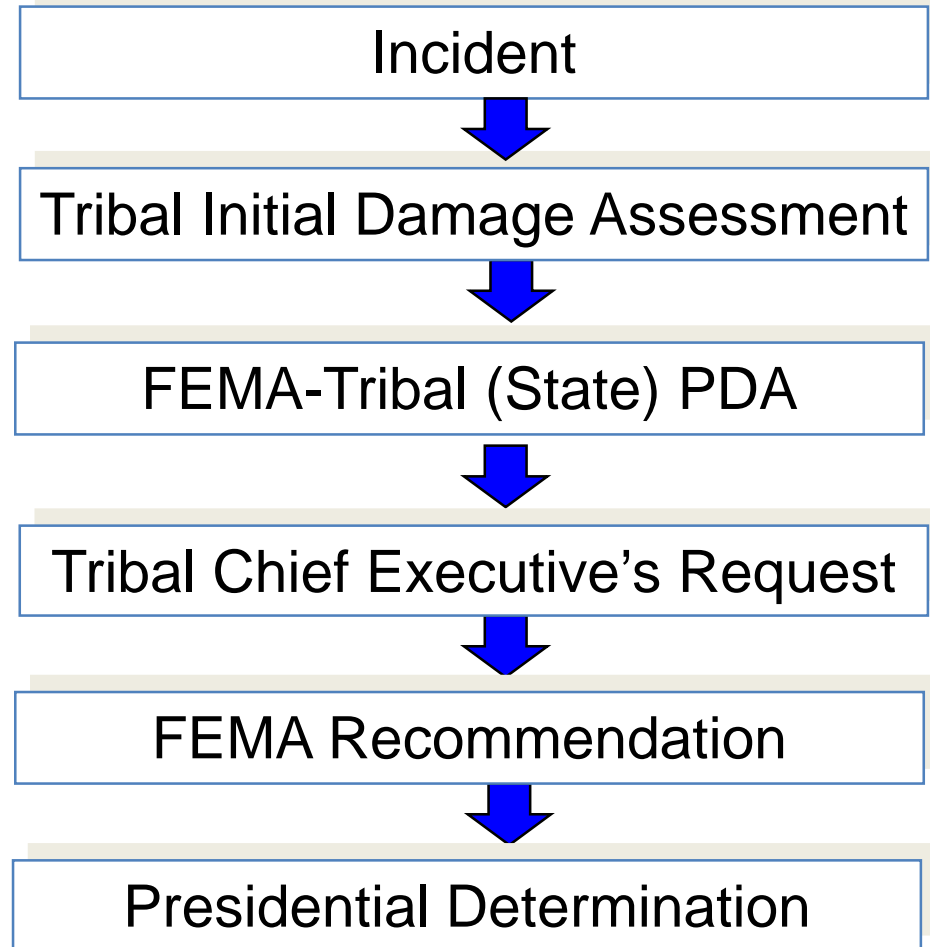
Rulemaking Process

Request must be submitted with **30** days of the incident

Stafford Act Assistance: Public Assistance



Emergency Work

- A. Debris Removal
- B. Emergency Protective Measures

Permanent Work

- C. Roads and Bridge Systems
- D. Water Control Facilities
- E. Public Buildings / Equipment
- F. Public Utilities
- G. Other (Parks, Recreation, etc.)

**Cost Share for Public Assistance is 75% Federal,
25% Non-Federal.
President is authorized to adjust this cost share.**

Stafford Act Assistance: Individual Assistance

- Individuals and Households Program (\$32,900 Maximum*)
 - Disaster Housing, which provides grants for rental assistance and/or home repairs (for privately owned homes) to survivors whose primary residences were damaged
 - Other Needs Assistance, which provides grants for replacement of personal property, transportation, medical, dental and funeral expenses
- Disaster Unemployment Assistance
- Crisis Counseling Program
- Disaster Legal Services
- Disaster Case Management

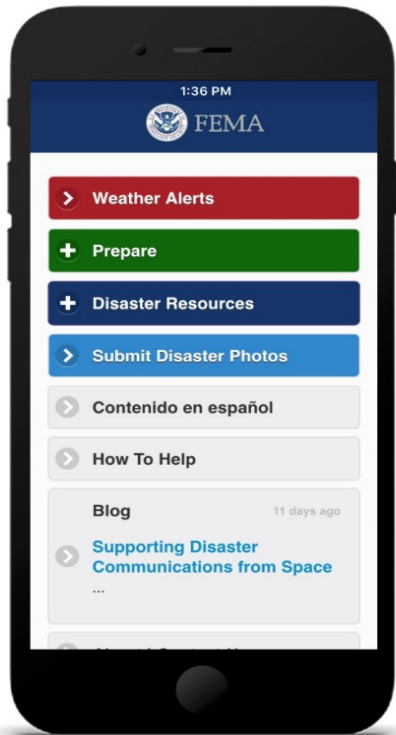
